Description: ALSTOM is ready whether you need more power by the hour or are just waiting for your ship to come in. The company makes power-distribution equipment for the transfer of electricity to large customers. ALSTOM is also a leading maker of rail equipment such as railcars and signaling devices. The company also makes luxury passenger ships (such as the Queen Mary 2), naval vessels, and natural gas tankers. Its Alstom Power subsidiary -- formed when it acquired ABB Asea Brown Boveri's stake in joint venture ABB Alstom Power - makes power-generation systems and constructs power plants. Other businesses include electrical drives, motors, and generators.
